Trustee Sheets made a motion to create a new TIF District. Consultants Moran Economic Development and Attorney Ken Beth will assist in setting this up. Trustee Washkowiak seconded the motion. All six Trustees present voted yea. Motion carried.

Trustee Wear made a motion to allocate \$135,000.00 to the Motor Fuel Tax Program. Fehr Graham will be administering our MFT Program. Trustee Sheets Seconded the Motion. All six Trustees present voted yea. Motion carried.
